

IMPORTANT! KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

Failure to follow these warnings and the instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Not intended for sleeping in playard mode.
- Always provide the supervision necessary for the continued safety of your child. When used for playing, never leave child unattended.
- Only use the product with one child at a time.
- Do not move the product with child inside.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome), pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their back to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- The product, including the side rails, must be fully erect prior to use. Make sure latches are secure.
- Never leave child in product with any sides lowered. Make sure that all sides are in raised and locked position whenever child is in product.
- Product should not be used without the mattress provided with the product.
- DO NOT use a water mattress with this product.
- Do not use a sheet designed to fit a full-sized crib. If sheet is used with the pad, only use one specifically designed to fit this playard mattress.
- Do not use the bassinet or playard if you cannot exactly follow these instructions.
- Do not modify playard or add any attachments that are not listed in the instruction guide.
- Keep carrying bag away from child.
- For indoor use only.
- Never place a child under the bassinet.
- Child can become entrapped and die when improvised netting or covers are placed on top of product. Never add such items to confine child in product.

FALL HAZARD

Playard:

- When a child is able to pull to standing position, remove bumper pads, large toys, and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- Discontinue use of the product when child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (890 mm) or weighs more than 30 lbs. (13.6 kg), whichever comes first.

Bassinet:

- To prevent falls, stop using the product when infant:
 - begins to push up on hands and knees OR
 - begins to pull up on product sides (approximately 5 months)
 - begins to roll over OR has reached 15 lbs, whichever comes first.
- ALWAYS secure this product to the playard using the zipper and buckles provided on this product.

STRANGULATION HAZARD:

- Strings can cause strangulation! Never place items with a string around a child's neck such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Never suspend strings over product or attach strings to toys.
- Never place product near a window or patio door where cords from blinds or drapes can strangle a child.
- Never leave the changing table attached to the playard when child is in the playard.
- Do not use the Dream Center[™] unless attached to the playard according to the manufacturer's instructions. Do not leave Dream Center[™] in place when child is in the bassinet or playard.

CHOKING HAZARD:

· Keep medication and small items that could choke a child away from the playard.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD:

Infants have suffocated:

- · on added pillows, blankets, and extra padding
 - Only use the pad provided by the manufacturer
 - Never place extra padding under or beside the infant.
 - Never add a mattress, pillow, comforter, or padding.
- when trapped between product and adjacent surface.
 - Only use when the product is securely attached to the playard
 - Never use this product with a different product.
- in gaps between extra padding and the side of products.
- on soft bedding.
- in gaps between a mattress too small or too thick and the side of the product.
- Always place infant on back to sleep.
- Do not use the playard unless all of the washable fabrics are properly attached using all securing devices.
- Do not use the mattress without the boards properly installed.
- Do not store the bassinet in the playard while using the playard.
- Babies have suffocated while sleeping in changing areas. Changing areas are not designed for safe sleeping.
- NEVER allow baby to sleep in changing area.
- NEVER use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers not sold and intended for that purpose. They can cause suffocation.

IMPORTANT

- Adult assembly required.
- Care should be taken in unpacking and assembly.
- Examine product frequently for damaged, missing, or loose parts.
- DO NOT use if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken.
- Contact Dream On Me for replacement parts and instructions if needed. Never substitute parts.
- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts, or sharp edges before assembly and periodically during use.

Changing Table:

- The weight limit of the changing table is 25 lbs. (11 kg).
- Children have suffered serious injuries after falling from changing tables. falls can happen quickly.
- Always stay within arm's reach of you child when using the changing table.
- ALWÁYSsecure this product to the playard using the attachment tubes or clips provided on this product. Make sure that the frame tubes are connected before attaching ching to the playard.
- Do not use the changing table as a sleeping or play area.
- STAY within arm's ref your child.
- Never leave child unattended.

A WARNING:

FALL HAZARD:Children have suffered serious injuries after falling from changing tables. Falls can happen quickly.

• STAY in arm's reach of your child.

• ALWAYS secure this product to the support frame by connecting mounting bracket short side rail and fastening both side buckles. See instructions.

SUFFOCATION HAZAR Babies have suffocated while sleeping in changing areas.

Changing areas are not designed for safe sleeping.

• NEVER allow baby to sleep in changing a Neaver leave changing station in place when child is in non-full size crib/play yard.






- Do not mix old and new batteries.

Assembly Instructions




Draw the four corner posts outward in all 4 directions. Notice that the top rails on each side is bent, connected by a joint. Straighten each side until it locks into place where you'll hear a clicking sound. If done correctly, the 2 adjacent rails become one long rail. See figure 2A and 2B.





Pull each corner in all 4 directions and push down on the middle bar in the center of the play yard towards the floor to lock all sides into place. See figure 3.




Place mattress pad on the bottom of play yard with soft side facing up. Align the velcro on the mattress pad to the velcro on the base of the play yard. Press down to make sure that the velcro is stuck together. See figure 4.




Put the Dream Center cover around the Dream Center frame and fasten all 4 buckles.




















Changing Table Storage


When changing table is not in use, it can be hooked onto the side of the playard for easy storage.















Removing the Bassinet














Removing the Washable Fabrics

Dream Center

Undo all of the buckles and remove the frame from the fabric cover. Remove the board from the opening in the back to wash the fabric whenever needed.



Care and Cleaning

Bassinet – Remove from frame. Machine wash in cold water, gentle cycle. Air dry flat. No bleach. spot clean with a soft, clean cloth and mild soup.

Mattress and Changing Table – Remove structural boards. Spot clean with a soft, clean cloth and mild soap. Air dry flat. No bleach.

Carry Bag – Machine wash in cold water on delicate cycle. Air dry. No bleach. Spot clean with a soft, clean cloth and mild soap.

Dream Center – Remove from frame. Remove structural boards. Fasten buckles. Machine wash in cold water, gentle cycle. Air dry flat. Spot clean with a soft, clean cloth and mild soap.
